BIG GATHERING: Temple courts

This is a common practice, as Christianity evolved through centuries. Even today large gathering has been the normal norm of every Christian to attend church services every Sunday.

After Christianity's legalization, grand basilicas, inspired by Roman basilicas (public halls), became common for worship.

HOUSE CHURCH MOVEMENT

The house church movement refers to Christian congregations that regularly gather for worship and fellowship in private homes rather than traditional church buildings. This movement is rooted in the early church's practice of meeting in homes, and it gained momentum in the 20th century as a way to re-establish New Testament principles.

2. FELLOWSHIP

SMALL GATHERING: House to house

HOUSE CHURCH MOVEMENT

The largest house church movement is in China, where it has become a significant force due to government restrictions on Christianity. These churches, known as family churches, operate independently from the state-sanctioned Three-Self Patriotic Movement and China Christian Council. In China, house churches are estimated to have around 35 million adherents.

2. FELLOWSHIP

SMALL GATHERING: House to house

CELL GROUP / SMALL GROUPS

Is a small group of (3-12 / 3-15) people outside the church building led by a cell leader, focused on evangelism, discipleship, and leadership development, with the goal of multiplying cells and leaders.





4. LEADERSHIP

(MULTIPLYING DISCIPLES)

In a "Disciple-making" context, leadership particularly within a church or ministry setting, refers to leadership development where each leader is expected to mentor and disciple others. Disciple-making emphasizes that everyone is a potential leader, capable of leading others and impacting their community.

4. LEADERSHIP

(MULTIPLYING DISCIPLES)

Leadership development is a core principle. It emphasizes the importance of each disciple becoming a leader by discipling and mentoring groups, similar to Jesus' selection of his 12 disciples. This strategy aims to multiply the church's reach through a network of influential leaders who each impact their families, social circles, and ministry settings.


